The Members of the Pleasant View Fire Department has a scholarship program for the purpose of aiding deserving students in our district to obtain a post high school education. The applicant or applicant's parents or legal guardian must live in the PVFD district in order for the student to qualify for a scholarship.

This scholarship shall be used for bona fide educational expenses as determined by the institution attended and must be used within the next school year following the grant of the scholarship or it will be forfeited by the recipient unless a delay is approved by the Members, we understand that there are sometimes extenuating circumstances.

Consideration will be given without regard to age, race, creed, color, sex or religious beliefs.

Please make sure that all items are furnished on the list below in order for the scholarship committee to make an informed decision about the applicant's eligibility for entry into the lottery styled drawing.

- A. Your most recent academic transcript from school.
- B. Copy of your college entrance examination (ACT and/or SAT) scores.
- C. Two letters of reference from a teacher, counselor, clergy or employer.
- D. Document high school activities, school and community honors and activities.
- E. Written essay outlining your career goals, family situation, including financial need, and why you are applying for this scholarship.

You may apply for a scholarship each year you attend school; the amounts awarded will be based on available funds during that year's application period. To be eligible for the scholarship, this completed application must be returned to the department at PVFD, PO Box 291, Pleasant View, CO 81331 by April 29 awards for the scholarship will be announced by May 15 of each year.

**The application will not be considered if any information is missing or incomplete.**

For identification purposes, your social security number will be requested should you be awarded one of our scholarships. The awarded scholarship will be made payable to the educational institution of students choice.
